ELIMINATION OF CIRCUIT COURT ARRAIGNMENTS

IT IS ORDERED:

This administrative order is issued in accordance with MCR 6.113, effective January 1, 2006. This order authorizes the Kent County 17th Circuit Court to eliminate the circuit court arraignment of juvenile delinquency cases seeking an adult sentence, cognizable in the circuit court.

- 1. Until further order of the court, in delinquency cases seeking an adult sentence, where the juvenile is represented by an attorney and arrangements have been made to give the juvenile a copy of the information, the judge of the Kent County 17th Circuit Court assigned to the juvenile's case, or assigned as the judge for the preliminary hearing, may eliminate the circuit court arraignment.
 - 2. The court shall make certain the juvenile or the juvenile's attorney has been properly served with a copy of the information, or acknowledges receipt of the same.
 - 3. The Kent County 17th Circuit Court will cooperate with the State Court Administrative Office in the assessment of this program.
