How to Submit a Parenting Time Complaint to Kent County FOC

FOC complaint enforcement is available if you can answer yes to all of these questions:

Do you have a **Kent County FOC case**?

Do you have a **parenting time order**? The FOC can only act on your complaint if there is a specific parenting time order.

Does your order include specific days and times (start and end times) for parenting time? The FOC cannot enforce orders when parents are exercising parenting time "as agreed" or "reasonable parenting time."

Did the other parent **deny you parenting time** on a **day** and **time** specified in your order? Did you show up at the correct **exchange location**?

Was the parenting time violation within the last **56** *calendar* days?







- What day and time are you saying the other parent violated the parenting time order?

You must include <u>both</u> the day and the time.

- A physical attempt means that you were at the exchange location at the court-ordered time.
- For example: You were at the other parent's residence on 7/1/22 at 6pm to pick up your child.
- A **physical attempt** is required for FOC to enforce your order.

You must include a location. If you check "Other," include the exact location, like 44th St. McDonald's or Mobil gas station in Lowell.


Words Are Not Enough...

Phone calls, text messages, emails or **statements** from the other parent stating you will not get parenting time do not count as parenting time violations.

Even if the other parent tells you they will not follow the order, you still need to **follow the order** and try to exercise your courtordered parenting time for FOC to act on your complaint.

Description: Tell us what happened...

Include important details like:

- When did you arrive at the exchange location? When did you leave? Note: we ask that parents wait at the exchange location for at least 30 minutes.
- Was the other parent at the exchange location? Did the other parent say anything?
- Was the child present at the exchange location?
- Did you get your child at a later day or time?
- Did you miss all or some of your parenting time?

Include all details on this one page. If you are submitting complaints for multiple violations, fill out complaint forms for each date.

Additional pages of more detail not accepted.

Why Can't I Provide More Information/Pages?

The complaint form is intended for FOC to determine whether there is a possible violation of your order.

If your complaint moves forward, you will have an opportunity to present additional evidence to FOC, if needed. You may also have an opportunity to present your evidence to the court.

FOC does not need all the information up front to determine whether we can move forward with your complaint.



What Happens After I Submit My Complaint? For Complaints FOC can act on:

FOC SENDS COPY

response, with a date the response is due. You will receive an email letting you know the complaint was sent to the other parent.

Note: If FOC cannot act on your complaint, you will receive your complaint back with an explanation.



RESPONSE

If FOC <u>receives</u> a response from the other parent, FOC will email it to you. You will have 7 days to let FOC know if you have resolved the complaint and do not want to proceed with enforcement.
