Arrears Clinic

The Kent County Friend of the Court is starting a program to help parents manage their support arrearages. We will identify cases that may be eligible for various arrear discharge options under existing rules and statutes. So, if your case is eligible, you may get a call or email from our Resources for Parents Program. The arrears clinic is a great opportunity to potentially eliminate thousands of dollars in arrears.
