Bailiff



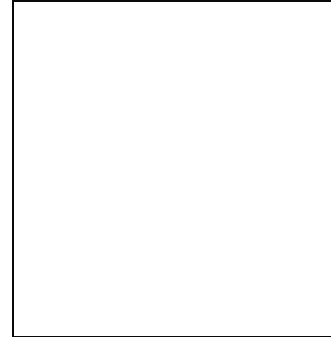
Makes sure the courtroom rules are obeyed.

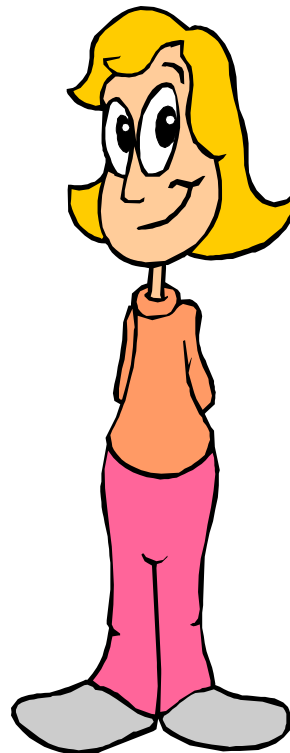

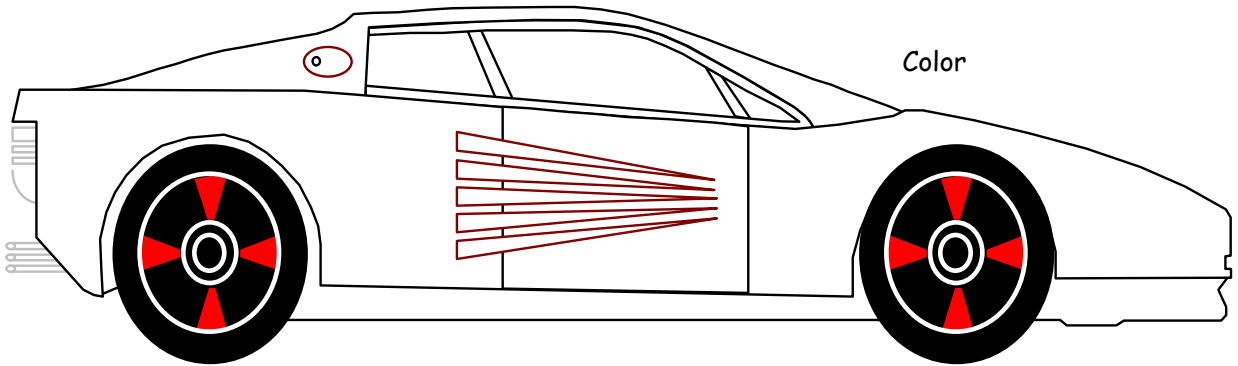
Tell What Really Happened

This is an airplane.



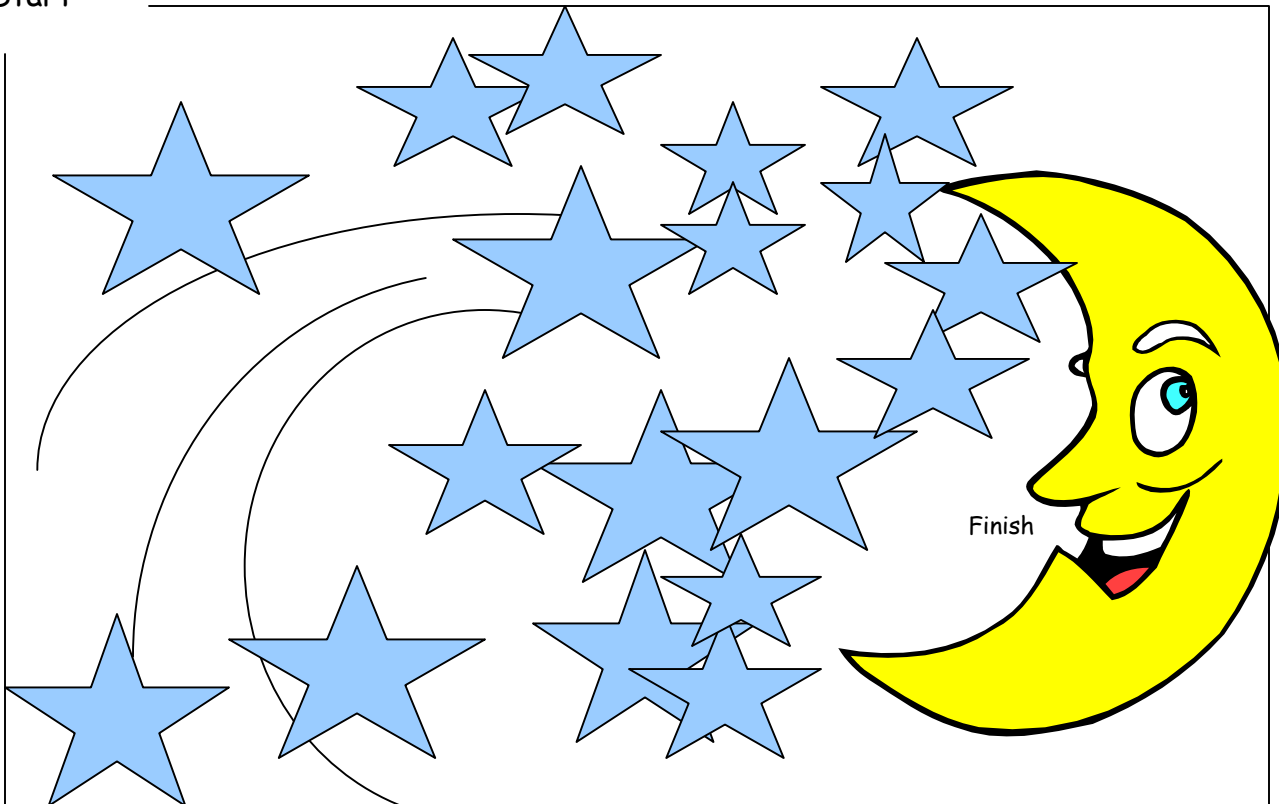

Then:

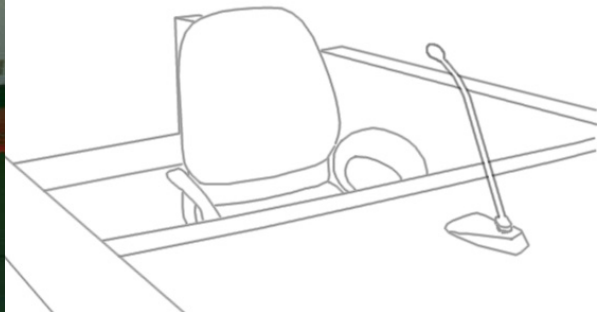
You will go into the courtroom and the judge will ask you to promise to tell the truth.

Draw a picture of yourself on the Witness Chair

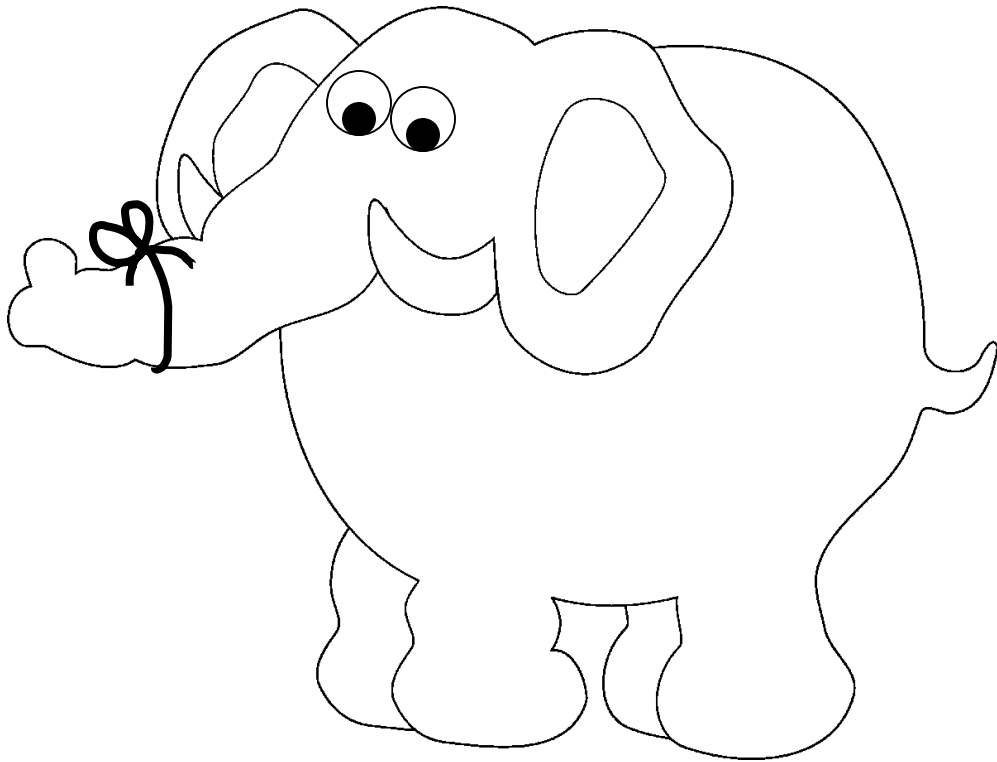
Later on, you may have to come back to court to tell a jury what happened.



The jury hears all the witnesses and then decides if the defendant is guilty or not guilty.

Judge	The person who tells the victim and the witnesses about court and answers questions. You can tell this person if you are afraid or worried.
Jury	The person who tries to show a judge or jury that the defendant broke the law.
Witness	The person accused of breaking the law.
Sentence	A person who saw the crime happen or knows about the crime.
Defendant	In court, the person who helps the defendant.
Victim Advocate	The person who sits in the highest chair in the courtroom and wears a black robe.
Prosecutor or Prosecuting Attorney	The people who hear all the witnesses and then decide if the defendant is guilty or not guilty.
Defense Attorney Or Defendant's Attorney	The punishment or special help the Judge says the defendant will get.
